



501c3 or God approved? It's your choice!

Yes, this appears to be an official seal. And I'm sharing it to inform on the general topic of '501c3'. What is '501c3' and why does it matter? Good questions. First, the '501c3' is a tax-exempt status from the central-bank called the 'Federal Reserve', and their silent bully, the illegal IRS. '501c3' is from the IRS 'tax-code' # 501, sub-section c, subsection 3 = '501c3'. What is it?
