This team here at INCPU realizes that not many Americans are familiar with the Rockefeller's UN (United Nations) and its workings... but that needs to change, and we need to work to push back on their invasions, and work to push them out of the US and back to the European Union area where they belong. ~ With that said, Americans need to realize that the Rockefellers have spy agents that watch people, here in the US and around the globe.
