Interfaith Hospitality Networks – now called Family Promise

Potential Sources of Family Promise Funding

A. Foundations

Private – These include foundations such as the Rockefeller Foundation.

Corporate – This is one of the formal ways large corporations give to nonprofits; examples include the JP Morgan Chase Foundation and the Citigroup Foundation.

Family – This is the formal giving vehicle for wealthy individuals and families.

Community – Can be city, county or statewide.

B. Corporations

Foundation – A 501(c)(3) giving vehicle that operates similarly to a private foundation

Corporate philanthropy – Formal giving program that is managed by the corporate staff

Community affairs – Makes smaller gifts to local nonprofit organizations, and usually has quick turnaround

Marketing – Funding events or programs as a way to increase corporate visibility among a targeted audience; this would be a good source of funding for major events such as a golf marathon

Employee-directed – Discretionary fund that supports those organizations recommended by employees

Matching gifts – Most large corporations and some small businesses have a fund to match – in whole or part – the charitable contributions of its individual employees

C. Government: Federal, state and local funding would include sources like the Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Compassion Capital Fund

D. Individuals: Through major gifts, direct mail appeals and participation in events

E. Congregations and Judicatories: Depending on source, capable of a wide range of gift sizes and annual pledges

F. Civic and Community Organizations: Rotary Clubs, United Way, Junior Leagues and small businesses are among the sources of funding

Search Interfaith Hospitality Network and Family Promise (name changed to Family Promise in 2003), and you will discover the direct partnership with United Way in the majority of these networks.

Here is how it got started in 1983 when United Way was appointed among an interfaith network of National/Global organizations to direct the FEMA Emergency Food and Shelter Program:

The Emergency Food and Shelter Program was established on March 24, 1983, with the signing of the "Jobs Stimulus Bill," Public Law 98-8. That legislation created a National Board, chaired by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) that consisted of representatives of the American Red Cross, Catholic Charities USA, The Jewish Federations of North America, National Council of the Churches of Christ in the USA, The Salvation Army and United Way Worldwide.

The EFSP was authorized under the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act (P.L. 100-77 signed into law on July 24, 1987, since renamed the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act and subsequently reauthorized under P.L. 100-628, signed into law on November 7, 1988). Since 1983, in its 34-year history, the EFSP will have distributed \$4.4 billion to over 14,000 human service agencies in more than 2,500 communities across the country through this collaborative effort between the private and public sectors.

The original authorizing legislation (PL 100-77) specifically calls for "sensitivity to the transition from temporary shelter to permanent homes and attention to the specialized needs of homeless individuals with mental and physical disabilities and illness and to facilitate access for homeless individuals to other sources of services and benefits."

Also in accordance with the legislation, the National Board encourages Local Boards, the decision-making local bodies, to place special emphasis on identification of and assistance to the elderly, families with children, Native Americans and Veterans. In addition, the authorization as revised (PL 102-550) in 1992 requires that a homeless or formerly homeless person serve on the Local Boards.

EFSP – Federal Emergency Food and Shelter Program – These are FEMA funds which are given to communities on a formula basis, specifically for emergency services such as shelters, food, utility/rent assistance, etc. Funds are distributed through committees facilitated by local United Ways agencies, though funds are not United Way funds and an organization does not need to be a United Way agency to receive the funds. Walt Disney's relationship with United Way since before World War 2 (Excerpts from)

Charities have always been important to Walt Disney, and he gave tirelessly (more on this in the future). This is a part of Walt that fortunately still continues to this day in the Walt Disney Company. A favorite charity of both the Walt era and the current era is the United Way of America. The organization was formed by church leaders in Denver, Colorado 1887 and throughout its history has become the leading charity in America. It went through numerous name changes over the 123 years and currently is the largest charity in the United States, giving close to \$5 billion a year in contributions to various worthy organizations. The Disney Studios under Walt was a big supporter of the United Way, in its many incarnations. This was especially true during World War II years, with the Community Chest, Blood Drives, and so forth (more on this in an upcoming book on Walt and the War by the Walt Disney Family Foundation Press, written by some famous Disney Historian). But in keeping with our tradition of Matterhorn Monday (sorry, in our family, if it happens once, it is a tradition!), I have tied this into the Mountain that the Admiral and Walt built at Disneyland. During the fall of 1962 when that year's fundraising campaign was underway for the United Way, Walt and his staff at Disneyland came up with a great way to celebrate being over the top for their contributions. As much as I would like to wax rhapsodic about the story, I believe Hans and Fritz tell the tale very adequately in the photos below. So, enjoy. When the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation said it would pay its next CEO more than its first, it wasn't kidding. While [Patricia Stonesifer](#) received a salary of just \$1 during her decade-long tenure, the current foundation Chief Executive [Jeffrey Raikes](#) receives the largest compensation of any CEO among 49 private foundations surveyed by the [Chronicle of Philanthropy](#). Raikes did not earn as much as the chief investment officers at foundations smaller than the Gates Foundation.

Stonesifer and Raikes were both early Microsoft employees who earned their fortunes building the software company.

Stonesifer refused to take a salary at the philanthropy. When [Raikes was hired](#), the Gates Foundation said it did not want to maintain a precedent of not paying its chief executive.

Raikes, who joined the Gates Foundation a year ago, earned \$315,403 from September through December 2008, making his annualized salary \$990,000, according to the Chronicle.

The next phase that is already starting seems to be to turn these into Community Resource Networks without any clear access to information about who is directing them or who their partners are. But I can assure you they will continue to be run by FEMA trained clergy.
