

Hello brothers and sisters in Christ, and friends,

I had a friend ask me why I cannot vote for Romney, since I obviously wouldn't vote for the moslem candidate. This is a partial answer. You are welcome to share your thoughts - I hope this conversation helps many :)

There has been a move on the subject of religions, for the old Roman Empire to continue to control. So, for our next stop, let's head over to what is none-other than, www.mormonism.org - the friendly face of Mormonism today - First paragraph looks kind of ok, but that's because most of us don't know what definitions they are using, yet. Ah, but it all becomes clear, starting in the second paragraph.

"God is our Heavenly Father, and like any parent He wants us, His children, to be happy. In the scriptures, He teaches "my work and my glory [is] to bring to pass the immortality and eternal life of man" (Moses 1:39). Eternal life means to live in heaven, in His presence, with our families, forever. God has given us commandments, which teach us what is right and wrong and chart a way through life that will offer the greatest happiness. Jesus Christ taught, "If ye love me, keep my commandments" (John 14:15). But the scriptures also teach that "no unclean thing can dwell with God" (1 Nephi 10:21). As hard as we try to live good lives, we all sin, so how can we live in God's perfect kingdom if we are imperfect?"

God sent Jesus Christ to earth to give us a way to overcome our sins and imperfections. "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)."

Yi, yi, yi. I hope I'm not the only one who just saw glaring errors and contradictions to the Bible. If you missed them, here are a few:

> They say that 'God is our Heavenly Father'. That's not a new lie. For any Christian who has forgotten that there are 2 spiritual families in this world, please remember this - when we intentionally rebel against a holy God, we are not His children - we are Satan's children. Jesus talked a lot about that in John 8 and John 10. It's only as we repent from our rebellious ways, turn from our sin, cling to and surrender to Christ, that we can then be adopted into God's family - until we are adopted, we are rebels, wasting away in our rebellion.

> Quoting the book of 'Moses'. Wow - that's new - or is it? Nope, not new, just mixing God's Word with Satan's lies.

> Quoting the book of 1st Nephi? Who's that?!? Obviously not someone I serve :) - I serve One, Jesus the Christ.

> And then they move to a nice little quote on God's perfect kingdom and talk about how their version of Jesus came to clear away their imperfections... Huh? Are the 10 Commandments 'suggestions'? No - we will either be found guilty of rebellion against them or be found cleansed by Christ's death on the cross. The Jesus of the Bible didn't come to improve us, but to save us. - That's totally different.

Okay, so back to www.mormon.org -

... if you were to use up precious time reading their carefully-worded next couple pages of text, you'd still find the lies, if you looked hard enough. But if you don't want to - I'll just sum it up for you.

Mormons believe that just like Jesus was created by God (yes they believe the Creator was 'created' as a baby), so they too can become 'gods' just like their version of Jesus. And they discount all the rebellious things they do as 'bad' and 'mistakes' and 'imperfections' that God can forgive us from. Oh, and they wrap it up with the common social false gospel that Rick Warren and many other false teachers describe - completely leaving out the making disciples for Jesus Christ.

I love one of the last quotes: *'The key is to think of the gospel of Jesus Christ as a pattern for living, rather than steps on a checklist. We can continue to develop our faith in Christ every day by reading His words in the scriptures and praying to our Heavenly Father.'*

If you didn't catch any errors there, please let me highlight 2 points - :)

> 'The key is to think of the gospel of Jesus Christ as a pattern for living...' ~ the gospel of Jesus Christ isn't a pattern for living - it's a clear-cut you come to Christ this way or you don't have Him. And, it's really a pattern for dying - dying to our self-centered wants and doing what Jesus said in Mark 8: **"When He had called the people to [Himself], with His disciples also, He said to them, "Whoever desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake and the gospel's will save it. For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul? For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him the Son of Man also will be ashamed when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels."** (Mark 8:34-38)

Mormons also believe that man can become saved through their works system, and at some later date, they can then become His followers. Yet, Jesus never separated those - either we are saved and following Him or we're not following Him and that shows we are not saved. The above passage in Mark is just one of many passages that show this.

Moving onto more about Mormonism:

Mormonism came out of Freemasonic Satanic worship beliefs (a mix of Egyptian, Babylonian, and Greek heresies, including perverse stuff). And Mormonism, like Freemasonry, is very similar to Satanism - because it's just a modification.
